This juxtaposition piece compares two common sayings: Absence makes the heart grow fonder, and out of sight, out of mind. In the top picture, two fish look longingly at each other. They love one another, but because of the restrictions of space, they cannot be together. The bottom picture exhibits the heartbreak of the female fish when a stack of books blocks the view of the two fish, and another female fish is placed next to the male fish. The male fish forgets completely about the love he once had when he can no longer see her. I am very proud of the overall theme we created in this piece. I believe the comic look gives it character and smoothness. I also like the story our fish create; it is both understandable yet simple. I think that it has a smooth, professional look. However, I am not overly fond of the bubble border. I think a simple line border may have better fit the theme we were trying to create. Additionally, the fish bowls are too full of water and are therefore not realistic. In real life, no one fills their fishbowl to the very brim. Overall, I am quite proud of this project, although I would make a few changes if given the chance.
